Henry Winkler, the son of wealthy parents, went to private schools in Switzerland and New York. Over the strong objections of his parents he became an actor. In 1970, he joined the Yale Repertory Theater Company; later he went to New York, where he did television commercials; finally, he went to Hollywood in 1973. After some initial small parts on several television shows, he auditioned on October 29, 1973, for the part of Arthur Fonzarelli on the television series "Happy Days." He got the part, and skyrocketed the ratings of "Happy Days" from #48 in 1974-75, to the top of the 1975-76 ratings. Today, Henry Winkler as "The Fonz," remains one of T.V.'s most popular and most loved personalities.
